



WHEN TO GO

Northern Thailand is a year round destination. The cool season coincides with the high season and begins in late October and ends in February. December and January are the coolest winter months. The hot season runs between March and May. The average daily temperature in March is 27° C rising to 36° C in April. The Monsoon season starts in May and ends in September. This is a particularly misty time of year but you can expect some sunshine on most days as it generally only rains in the afternoon, evening and night time. Aside from the rain, the weather is lovely and mild with average temperatures hovering at around 25° C.

WHERE TO STAY

Maldivian cuisine reflects the pure simplicity of island life. Waters teeming with fish encapsulate 26 island atolls,



where coconuts grow in abundance. It therefore comes as no surprise that seafood, coconut milk, fresh fruit and imported rice form the staples of local recipes. For sweet-tooths. desserts include coloured coils of sugared fried batter known as zileybee, tiny bananas and rice pudding. Traditionally, Maldivians will conclude a meal with a thinly sliced areca nut blended with cloves and lime juice, wrapped in an areca leaf, a piquant punch for an acquired taste!

Aluvi Kiru Garudhiya - Curried Potato Soup (Main)

En'di Kaashi Kiru - Coconut Crème Brûlée (Dessert)

The camp's main tent has a split level lounge, swimming pool, restaurant and viewing platforms with outlooks across the river and rugged landscape beyond. Yet it is the incredible proximity of the wild which takes the experience of this camp to an altogether higher level.




